

Conference Rules and Regulations

General Delegate Conduct

Attire

- Delegates are required to wear Western formal attire, including full-sleeve formal shirts, formal trousers and formal shoes.
- While ties, blazers, vests, or full suits are not mandatory, they are recommended.
- Delegates in Indian committees (AIPPM) are allowed to wear Indian attire and sandals.
- Skirts and dresses are **not allowed** under any circumstances.
- Crop tops, sleeveless tops, backless tops or deep v-neck tops are absolutely prohibited.
- Casual attire such as jeans and sneakers are not allowed.

Decorum

- The conference will not tolerate any instances of verbal or physical harassment or discrimination based on race, gender, nationality, sexual orientation, caste, creed or religion both outside and within the committee sessions.
- The conference follows a strict zero-tolerance towards the abuse of narcotics, alcohol, cigarettes, vape pens or substances of any kind.
- Delegates found violating this policy will be prohibited from attending the remainder of the conference and will be reported to a faculty advisor immediately.
- Delegates are not permitted to visit other committees when the session is in progress, except for the IPC delegates.
- Delegates are expected to respect school property, including but not limited to, tables, chairs, walls, etc.
- It is imperative that delegates clean up after themselves and avoid littering on campus.

Delegates must adhere strictly to these regulations. Any violations will result in immediate expulsion from the remainder of the conference.
